Local roadways and access points will be impacted due to the Spark!Fishers festival beginning Tuesday, June 25 through Saturday, June 29. An overview of closures is below. Please note that on Saturday, June 29, 116th Street from Municipal Drive to Holland Drive will be closed from 5:30 to approximately 8 p.m. for the parade (exceptions will be made for emergency personnel). Drivers should use 106th Street and 126th Street for thru traffic.

Tuesday, June 25: Tuesday Night Concert at NPD AMP

- No parking in the north Fire Department lot and north City Services lot after 4:30 p.m. Cars must be removed by this time.
- South City Services lot reserved for ADA parking after 4:30 p.m. Cars must be removed by this time.
- No road closures.

Wednesday, June 26: 1 Mile Walk/Run & 5K Race

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

- No parking around Municipal Drive loop, Central Green, and in north Fire Department lot after 4:30 p.m. Cars must be removed before this time.
- Flexware and Ellipse parking lots closed from 4:30-8 p.m. (no access due to 5K route)
- South Fire lot reserved for ADA parking.

GARAGE RESTRICTIONS

- No entry from Municipal Drive into the Switch Garage from 6 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Switch Garage open for entry/exit from North Street until 7 p.m. North Street access to the Switch garage will be restricted from 7-9 p.m.
- No entry from Municipal Drive into Depot Garage from 6 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. (enter/exit on Fishers Center Drive).

ROAD CLOSURES & RESTRICTIONS (view route map at SparkFishers.com/5k)

- Beginning at 3:30 p.m.
 - West side of Municipal Drive closed between Fishers Center Drive and NPD AMP.
- Beginning at 6 p.m.
 - All Municipal Drive closed.
- Beginning at 7 p.m.
 - 126th Street eastbound lane from Lantern Road to Nickel Plate Trail closed until all race participants have cleared area (approximately 8 p.m.)
 - No left turn out of Fishers YMCA or from Markay Drive onto 126th Street (must travel westbound on 126th) until race participants have cleared area.



- Restricted access onto 126th Street from Trophy Drive until race participants have cleared area. No right turn onto 126th Street, limited left turns depending on participant traffic.
- Lantern Road between Technology Way and 126th Street closed until 8 p.m.
- North Street westbound lane beginning at Maple Street closed until 8:30 p.m.

Thursday, June 27: Car & Art Show

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

- No street parking around Central Green.
- South Fire Department lot reserved for ADA parking
- South City Services lot closed.
- No street parking on east side of Municipal Drive from 2:30-5:30 p.m.

GARAGE RESTRICTIONS

- Beginning at 2 p.m.
 - No access to Depot Garage from Municipal Drive (must enter/exit from Fishers Center Drive).
 - No access to Switch Garage from Municipal Drive (must enter/exit from North Street).
 - Right turn only from Police Garage onto Municipal Drive.

ROAD CLOSURES

- Beginning at 2 p.m.
 - East and west sides of Central Green on Municipal Drive closed.
 - No eastbound traffic at the intersection of Fishers Center Drive and Municipal Drive (must travel left/north toward Lantern Road).
 - No westbound traffic at the intersection of North Street and Municipal Drive (must travel right/north toward Lantern Road).

Friday, June 28: Friday Night Concert & Fireworks

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

- No curb parking (parallel parking) along Municipal Drive adjacent to Flexware, Ellipse, and Library.
- No parking in the north Fire Department lot and north City Services lot after 4:30 p.m.
- South City Services lot reserved for ADA parking.
- Holland Park is open for walk-ins until 8 p.m., but the parking lot will be closed all day for the fireworks launch that evening. Holland Park will be closed during the fireworks show and is NOT a viewing area.

Saturday, June 29: Street Fair & Parade

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

- No street parking around Municipal Drive and Central Green.
- No street parking on Lantern Road between Commercial Drive and 116th Street.
- North and South Fire Department lots closed.
- North and south City Services lots closed.
- Parking pass required for Flexware lot after 12:30 p.m.
- Parking pass or ADA tag required for Ellipse lot after 12:30 p.m.
- Alhuda Foundation lot closed.
- Launch Fishers lot closed.



GARAGE RESTRICTIONS

- Parking pass or resident pass required for Switch Garage beginning at 12:30 p.m. (must enter/exist from North Street).
- Police Garage closed beginning at 12:30 p.m.
- No entry/exit to Depot Garage from Municipal Drive (must use Fishers Center Drive). Access to Depot Garage will be restricted during parade from 5:30-8 p.m.
- Access to Nickel Plate Station, Edge and Spark Garages restricted during parade from 5:30-8 p.m.

ROAD CLOSURES & RESTRICTIONS

- Beginning at 12:30 p.m.
 - Municipal Drive and east/west Central Green closed for event setup (must have parking pass or ADA pass to access).
 - Municipal Drive and Lantern Road intersection closed to public (must have parking pass or ADA parking pass to enter).
 - Municipal Drive and Fishers Center Drive intersection closed.
 - Municipal Drive and North Street intersection closed.
 - North Street between Maple Street and Municipal Drive will operate with a soft closure for thru traffic (only open for business/local traffic and those with parking passes for Switch Garage).
- From 5:30-8 p.m. for Parade (*reopen time is approximate and subject to change*)
 - 116th Street closed between Commercial Drive and Holland Drive (both eastbound & westbound lanes).
 - Intersections off 116th Street closed including: Lantern Road, Maple Street, Moore Street, Municipal Drive, Manship Lane, Fishers Center Drive, Fishers Point Blvd, Regency Drive, Bostic Place, and Holland Drive.
 - Lantern Road closed between 116th Street and Sunblest Blvd.
 - Intersections off Lantern Road closed including: Sunblest Blvd., 121st/Regency Drive, Circle Drive, Municipal Drive, Technology Way, Commercial Drive, North Street, Station Street, and 116th Street.
 - Holland Drive closed between 116th Street and Ellipse Parkway/Holland Park.
 - Intersections off Holland Drive closed including: 116th Street, Madden Drive, Hampton Place, Sunblest Blvd. South, Ashton Drive, and Ellipse Parkway.
 - Southeast portion of Ellipse Parkway closed between Holland Drive and Sunblest Blvd.
 - Sunblest Blvd. closed between Ellipse Parkway and Lantern Road.
 - Intersections off Sunblest Blvd. Including: Turkel Drive and Torberg Place.

Saturday Public Parking Info:

- Spark!Fishers attendees are encouraged to park at the FORUM Conference Center (11313 USA Parkway) and take the free shuttle that will run from 2 to 10 p.m. Shuttles will stop between 5 and 7 p.m. due to the parade. Shuttles will resume at 7 p.m. and end at 10 p.m.
- Surface lots around Municipal Drive will not be available to Spark!Fishers guests as well as street parking on Lantern Road. Public parking is available in The Edge, The Depot, Nickel Plate Station, First Internet Bank, and Spark Apartments garages. The Switch and Police Department Garages require passes to enter.
- ADA parking for Saturday is located in the Ellipse parking lot. ADA parking is available at all Spark!Fishers events. Visit SparkFishers.com/Parking for details.
